The following is a sample outline demonstrating how to complete this bachelor's degree in 4 years (8 semesters) for an on-campus program, with the first two years completed at Snow College and the last two years completed at SUU. This is a GUIDE ONLY. Students should meet with their Student Success Advisor and consult Degree Works for specifics. Each student's reality will vary slightly, as this plan does not include prior learning credits, such as transfer work, advanced placement (AP), or concurrent enrollment credits. Math and English placement will be based on the student's ACT/SAT scores or other placement tests

PLEASE NOTE: The following plan assumes students are prepared to take the Math course listed. If prerequisites are required, additional semesters may be necessary to complete the degree.

- Any courses taken as part of the Physical Education-Teaching Emphasis major and Teacher Education (EDUC, SCED, etc.), including those taken at Snow College, must be passed with a C- grade or better

- If student graduates with an AS in Physical Education Teaching Emphasis at Snow, GE requirements are considered satisfied. However, if student does not obtain an AS before transferring, a one-credit Integrated Learning GE course will also be required.

- This agreement is based upon SUU 25-26 catalog requirements. If any changes are made in future catalogs, or anytime Snow or SUU make a change to degree requirements, this agreement would need to be reviewed.
