The following is a sample outline demonstrating how to complete this bachelor's degree in **4 years (8 semesters)** for an **on-campus program, with the first two years completed at Snow College and the last two years completed at SUU**. This is a GUIDE ONLY. Students should meet with their Student Success Advisor and consult Degree Works for specifics. Each student's reality will vary slightly, as this plan does not include prior learning credits, such as transfer work, advanced placement (AP), or concurrent enrollment credits. Math and English placement will be based on the student's ACT/SAT scores or other placement tests.

PLEASE NOTE: The following plan assumes students are prepared to take the Math course listed. If prerequisites are required, additional semesters may be necessary to complete the degree.
