


# **Qualtrics Survey Guidelines for Faculty supporting Undergraduate Research**

#### **Basic Guidelines**

- You will need to sign up for a free Qualtrics
   Account. The free account provides some features
   that fulfill your needs (see free account features).
   The account is required for collaborations on survey
   projects. Note: your students will need to have a
   free account as well to collaborate.
- You will need to request a Qualtrics folder from Beckie Hermansen. She will set up this folder which will include the <u>Student Research Survey Template</u>. All student projects under your supervision will be located in this folder.
- 3. You will need to communicate the name of each student project wanting a digital survey to Beckie Hermansen with the following information:
  - a. Name of student research project
  - b. Name of the student serving as the principal investigator or group/team leader
  - c. Email of the student serving as the principal investigator or group/team leader
- 4. Beckie will set up the basic framework of each survey and will send out collaboration invites to you and to the student serving as the principal investigator.
- 5. As the faculty advisor, you will have oversight on student survey development (content, grammar, distribution, and data analysis).
- 6. Faculty advisors over student research projects should have completed training involving human subjects research either through <u>CITI</u> or <u>HHS.gov</u>.
- 7. Faculty advisors over student research projects are encouraged to explore the following Qualtrics trainings:
  - a. Survey Basic Overview
  - b. Question Types
  - c. Results Reports Basic Overview
  - d. Distributions Basic Overview

## **Qualtrics Student Research Parameters**

- Surveys for student projects will collect data only using anonymous distribution links.
- Data collection must end no later than **one week prior to the end of each semester**. This allows for all students to concentrate on their end-of-semester/finals preparation activities. It also affords the student researcher/team time to analyze the data and prepare their findings for presentation.



- All data collected by the student survey will be deleted the day after final grades are posted for the semester.
- All student collaborations will be deleted from survey projects the day after final grades are posted for the semester.
- Student surveys will be deleted from your faculty folder on August 1 of each year unless otherwise communicated.
- Student research projects will use a standard theme and not any of the Snow College themes or branding.
- Surveys associated with student research that requires IRB approval will not be set up until approval has been affirmed.

## **What is a Qualtrics Free Account**

Qualtrics offers a <u>free survey account</u> that allows prospective users to get a sense of the
Qualtrics platform as they consider purchasing a full license. The purpose of the <u>free</u>
<u>survey account</u> is to provide an environment where the point-and-click user interface can
be experienced by building a survey, distributing it, collecting a few responses, and
experimenting with our analysis and reporting tools on the back-end. The Qualtrics <u>free</u>
<u>survey account</u> allows for collaborations between Qualtrics users.

#### What are the features of a Qualtrics free account

- You can only have 3 active surveys at a time
- You are limited to only 500 responses per account. This includes retaken and deleted responses.
- Surveys are limited to only 30 questions
- Question types are limited to multiple choice, text entry, text/graphic, matrix table, slider, form field, rank order, and side-by-side.
- Survey logic includes only skip logic, display logic, and branch logic
- No workflows are allowed
- Limited Look and Feel (theme/templates).
- Other features/limitations
